Blumenau is located in the southern region of Brazil, in the state of Santa Catarina. Founded by German immigrants in 1850, the city has developed into a dynamic urban center with an estimated population of 367,930 residents as of 2025. It ranks as the third-largest city in the state, following Joinville and Florianópolis. Blumenau also boasts a very high Human Development Index (HDI) of 0.806, reflecting strong achievements in education, healthcare, and income.
